Hi Peter,

I want to address several statements in the September 3 report that appear subjective, unsupported, or unrelated to the barn inspection.

The report refers to a "new locked gate." That gate has been installed since 2015. I do not understand the basis for calling it new, or how the age of the gate is relevant to the inspection.

The report also states that you "feel" only about 30% of the craft area is being used for crafts. Please explain how that percentage was determined and what code, safety, occupancy, or other regulatory standard makes that percentage relevant to the CO. The same applies to the characterization of the room as "living space" and the detailed listing of its furnishings.

The report also references the Windfall Cabin and states that we declined an inspection. The September 3 inspection was scheduled as the final inspection for the barn. The Windfall Cabin is a separate structure with a separate permit and is not part of the barn permit. If MRI expected to inspect the cabin during the same visit, that should have been arranged in advance as part of the scheduled inspection. Please clarify why this was included in the barn inspection report and whether it has any relevance to the barn CO.

If these statements relate to an actual inspection finding, please identify the applicable code or regulatory basis. If they do not, I am requesting that the subjective or unrelated language be removed or revised to reflect objective facts relevant to the inspection.
